




Assembly

1 Assembling the legs

□ Assemble the legs (E) with the leg connectors (F).



NOTE: No screws are needed in this step.




2 Attaching the legs to the lounge chair body

 Place the lounge chair body (D) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface. Attach the legs (E) and leg connectors (F) to the lounge chair body (D) using M6 hex bolts (AA), spring washers (BB), and washers (CC).




NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the M6 wrench (FF) to tighten.



3 Positioning the lounge chair and adding the cushions

- □ Turn the lounge chair over and set it down on its legs.
- □ Place the seat cushion (A), back cushion (B) and pillow (C) on the lounge chair.



Care and Cleaning

- □ Do not allow water to build up in the frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. Do not use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients may cause discoloration or have an adverse reaction to your finish.
- □ Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, absorbent cloth towel.
- □ Treat the frames with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.



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





Assembly


1 Attaching the table legs

- Attach a table leg (B) to each end of a leg connector (D) using hex bolts (AA) and washers (BB). Tighten the hex bolts (AA) with the M6 wrench (DD). Attach caps (CC) on hex bolts (AA).
- Assemble the two remaining table legs (B) and the table connector (D) in the same manner.




2 Attaching the table legs

Attach the assembled table legs (B) and leg connectors (D) to each end of the center connector (C) using the hex bolts (AA) and washers (BB). Tighten the hex bolts (AA) with the M6 wrench (DD).



3 Attaching the table top

Place the table top (A) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
 Attach the assembled legs (B) to the table top (A) using the hex bolts (AA) and washers (BB). Tighten the hex bolts (AA) with the M6 wrench (DD). Attach caps (CC) on the bolts (AA).



$m{4}$ Positioning the table

Turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
