



Assembly

1 Attaching the table legs and the support tubes

- □ Place the table top (A) on a soft surface.
- □ Attach the table legs (B) and the support tubes (C) to the table top (A).




Assembly (continued)

2 Attaching the leg connector

- Attach the leg connector (D) to the table legs (B) and the support tubes (C) using M6x25 combination hex bolts (BB).
- \Box Use the wrench (EE) to loosely tighten the M6x25 combination hex bolts (BB).
- □ Secure the support tubes (C) to the table top (A) by using ST5x12 screws (AA).
- Once all bolts and screws are in place, tighten all bolts and screws completely, and place M6 bolt covers (CC) over the bolts.



NOTE: The self-drilling tool is not included for ST5x12 screws.



Assembly (continued)

3 Checking the table

- □ Turn the table right side up.
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.



Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the frame with a damp cloth, and dry throughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- □ Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- □ Store the table in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the table out of fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
