OPERATION CHECKLIST

1 CHECKING OPERATION

Each of the functions has been factory checked before shipping. However, it is suggested that you verify the operation of the oven once more. Refer to the Owner's Manual. Follow the instructions for the basic check.

- 1. Turn on power supply. The initial signal sound is heard and the LG logo appears in the display.
- 2. Check the operation of the broil mode. When the oven is set to broil, the upper element in the oven should become red. After a few minutes, partially open the oven door. You should feel heat from the oven. Press CLEAR/ OFF (for model: LWS3081ST, LWD3081ST, LWS3010ST, LWD3010ST, LWS3063ST, LWD3063ST, LWS3063BD, LWD3063BD) or adjust the oven mode knob to OFF position (for model: LSWS306ST, LSWD306ST)
- 3. Check the operation of the bake mode. After setting the oven to 350 °F / 177 °C for baking, the temperature of the oven in the display should increase. Press CLEAR/OFF (for model: LWS3081ST, LWD3081ST, LWS3010ST, LWD3010ST, LWD3063ST, LWD3063ST, LWD3063BD, LWD3063BD) or adjust the oven mode knob to OFF position (for model: LSWS306ST, LSWD306ST)
- 4. Check the operation of the convection bake mode. After setting the oven to 350 °F / 177 °C for convection baking, the fan inside the oven should come on with the door closed. Press CLEAR/OFF (for model: LWS3081ST, LWD3081ST, LWD3081ST, LWD3010ST, LWD3010ST, LWD3063ST, LWD3063SD, LWD3063BD) or adjust the oven mode knob to OFF position (for model: LSWS306ST, LSWD306ST)
- 5. Turn on and off the oven light to check the lights are in normal condition.
- 6. Check the operation of the burner for each convection mode. After setting the oven to 350 °F / 177 °C for each convection mode, the back element should light up and the fan inside the oven should come on with door closed. (for model: LWS3081ST, LWD3081ST, LWD3010ST, LWD3010ST)

IMPORTANT NOTE

- A small amount of smoke and odor may be noticeable during the initial break-in period.
- If the oven does not operate properly or an F-, followed by a number, appears in the display, see the Owner's Manual for the troubleshooting list. The list includes common occurrences that are not the result of defective workmanship or materials in this product. If the problem occurs continuously, contact the dealer.
