IMPORTANT

- (1)Your bunk bed should be assembled in the room where it is to be used;
- (2)It is recommended to assemble your bunk bed on a pad in order to protect the finish;
- (3)It requires at least 3 persons to assemble your bunk bed;

Do not tighten the bolts and nuts until each part is in its assembled place.

STEP 1

Assemble the right and left frames (A,B---determine the left or right by the decoration panels welded on the frames) with the 2 support rail(E)by using 8 mid bolts (L),4 lock nuts(N) and 12 washers (o) and cement pad (S)---ref. To Fig.1.




STEP 2

Attach the top shelf(C) to the frames(A,B) with 8 mid bolts (L),4 lock nuts(N) and 12 washers (O)-ref. To Fig. 2.




STEP 3

Fix the guardrails(D) and plastic pad (U) to the frames (A,B) with 8 long bolts (K),8 lock nuts (N) and 16 washers (O)-ref. To Fig. 3.




STEP 4

Fix the right and left(H,I) to frames with 4 short bolts (M),4 lock nuts (N)and 8 washers(O)-ref. To Fig. 4.




STEP 5

Fix the bottom shelf(F) and back bottom shelf (G) onto the Futon linds (H,I) with 8 short bolts (M), 8 lock nuts (N) and 16 washers (O)-ref. To Fig. 5.




STEP 6

Fix the support leg (J) to the from bottom shelf (F) with a mid bolt (L) and a washers (O)-ref. To Fig. 6.




Fix two support rail (P) to the from bottom shelf (F) and the back bottom shelf(G) -ref. To Fig.7.







Tighten all the bolts and nuts and the assembly is finished.

C STYLE BUNK BED OWNER'S MANUAL

Dear Customer:

Thank you for selecting one of our bunk beds. Before assembling your bunk bed, please read this manual carefully.

WARNINGS

Follow the warnings appearing on one of the upper bunk end structures and on the carton. **DO NOT REMOVE WARNING LABEL FROM BED.**

The mattress foundation is designed to support a mattress without the need for a posture board or box-spring.

Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.

To prevent injury, it is recommended to use one twin size mattress on upper bunk and one full (double) size mattress on lower bunk.

Use only a mattress that is 74" -75" long and 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " -38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide on either bunk.

Use only a mattress that is 74" -75" long and 53" -54" wide on either bunk.

Ensure thickness of mattress and foundation combined does not exceed 6" .

Mattress surface must be at least 5" (127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.

Do not allow children less than 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.

Periodically check and ensure that the guardrails, ladders and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.

Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.

Do not use substitute parts. Contact your local dealer for replacement parts, including guardrails from Ergocraft Inc.

Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.

Always use guardrails on both sides of the upper bunk.

Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.

The use of water or sleep flotation mattress on this bed is prohibited.
