Operating Instructions

Product & Battery Installation

- Attach the alarm to a window using the peel and stick adhesive.
- ☐ Slide off the battery cover in the lower part of the front panel.
- Install 3 fresh AG13 (LR44) button cell batteries (included). Replace the battery cover.

Operation

- ☐ Slide the ON/OFF switch to ON.
- The alarm enters armed status after 5 seconds of the LED flashing. and a short beep sound.
- ☐ The alarm sounds for 30 seconds upon detecting window vibration or shaking, and returns to armed status after activation.
- ☐ Slide the switch to OFF to stop the alarm at any time.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
The device does not sound off after activation.	Ensure the battery is correctly installed, and the power switch is in the ON position.
Alarm sound becomes low.	Replace with new batteries.
