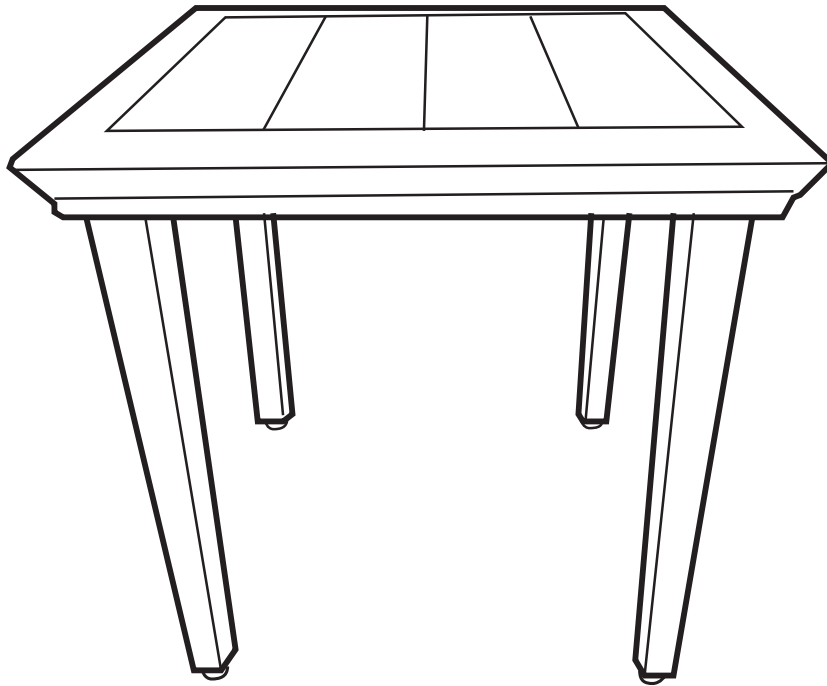

Identify all parts packed in the carton against the parts list. Remove all protective materials and place the parts on a nonabrasive surface to avoid scratching.

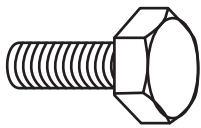

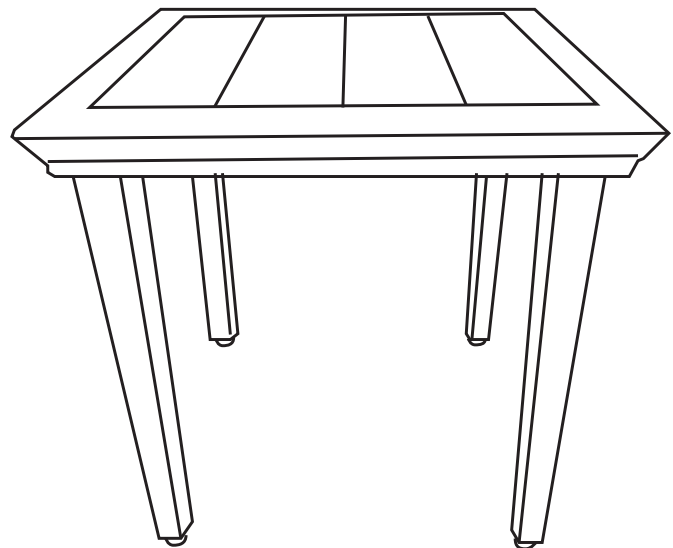
1 Attaching the table legs

- Place the table top (A) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
- Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) using washers (BB) and hex bolts (AA).
- Ensure all the bolts are aligned and assembled correctly.
- Tighten all the hex bolts (AA) using wrench (DD).
Attach all the hex bolts caps (CC).



2 Positioning the table

- Turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
- The table is now ready for use.



Care and Cleaning

- Do not allow water to build up in frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. DO NOT use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients may cause discoloration or have an adverse reaction to your finish.
- Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, absorbent cloth towel.
- Treat frames with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.
