Return & Refund Policy

Unopened toilet Seat can be returned and refunded only within 30 days of purchase. Open toilet seat is not eligible for return and refund.

Purchase order or receipt must be provided to TOPSEAT for return and refund.

Customer pays for the return cost if the toilet seat received has no problem.

Please cover the toilet seat with plastic wrapper like original to protect the bumpers of seat and surface, and carefully pack the seat to ensure the seats are not damaged in shipment. Please use a trackable carrier for shipment including the purchase order invoice or receipt in the package.

TOPSEAT Toilet Seat Cleaning

Toilet seats should be cleaned using mild hand soap and water. Antibacterial hand soap or dish soap can be used to fight against germs.

Do not use bleach, pine oils, essential oils, chlorine, acid, scouring powders, detergents, disinfectants, or products in aerosol cans.

Harsh chemicals can damage the paint finish, bumpers, and the metal finish on hinges. This can create a dull look on plastic toilet seats and a dirty worn-away look on molded wood seats as well as corrosion and peeling of the metal hinge finish. The bumpers may change color or become weakened such that they fail under compression.
