Uncoated Concrete or Masonry Surfaces: Allow new surfaces to cure 30 days. Clean and etch surface using a product such as BEHR PREMIUM No. 991 Concrete & Masonry Cleaner & Etcher to achieve a textured profile similar to 150 grit sandpaper. Apply a product such as Behr Premium No. 880 Concrete & Masonry Bonding Primer to increase adhesion of topcoat to the surface. Painted Surfaces-Concrete: For a painted surface in sound condition, use a product such as BEHR PREMIUM No. 990 Concrete & Masonry Degreaser & Cleaner to clean and prepare the surface. If the coating is failing or peeling, use a paint stripper such as BEHR PREMIUM No. 992 Concrete & Masonry Paint Stripper to remove old coating or scrape/sand down to a sound concrete surface. Scuff sand glossy surfaces. Clean and spot etch any exposed concrete using a product such as BEHR PREMIUM No. 991 Concrete & Masonry Cleaner & Etcher. Remove all dust with a damp cloth, allow to dry. Spot prime all uncoated areas with a product such as BEHR PREMIUM No. 880 Concrete & Masonry Bonding Primer to increase adhesion of topcoat to the surface. Follow all label instructions.

APPLICATION

Intermix all cans of same product to ensure colour uniformity. Stir stain before and occasionally during application. Use product when air and surface temperatures are between 10-32° C. Apply a thin, even coat using a 6-10 mm nap roller cover, pad applicator, a nylon/polyester brush or an airless sprayer with an adjustable tip (.015"-.019", 60 mesh ilter). Use long, even strokes in one direction to avoid lap lines. Spread rate varies, depending on the surface texture, porosity and application method. Do not thin if using a roller or brush; however, if using a sprayer and thinning is required, thin with water at a rate of no more than 236 ml per 3.79 L. Additional coats may be required for optimal hide and durability. Periodic touch-ups may be necessary.

DRY TIME

Longer dry time required in cooler temperatures and higher humidity. Allow 24 hours for light foot traffic. Allow 72 hours before subjecting surface to automotive tires. repositioning planters or furniture. Park tires on corrugated cardboard for 14 days after applying stain. After 30 days, dry stained surface may be cleaned with a mild, non-abrasive liquid detergent.

DISPOSAL
