





CONTROL PANEL OVERVIEW

UPPER OVEN

Name	Description
UPPER TIMER ON/OFF	Use to set or cancel the timer of the upper oven.
2 UPPER LIGHT	Use to turn the oven lights of the upper oven on and off.
3 UPPER CLEAR/OFF	Use to stop cooking, cancel settings of the upper oven.
4 CONV. BAKE	Use to select the Convection Bake function of the upper oven.
S CONV. ROAST	Use to select the Convection Roast function of the upper oven.
6 CRISP CONV.	Use to select the Crisp Convection function of the upper oven.
WARM/PROOF	Use to select the Warm/Proof function of the upper oven.
8 SELF CLEAN	Use to select the Self Clean function of the upper oven.
9 BAKE	Use to select the Bake function of the upper oven.
10 ROAST	Use to select the Roast function of the upper oven.

Name	Description
LOWER TIMER ON/OFF	Use to set or cancel the timer of the lower oven.
I LOWER LIGHT	Use to turn the oven lights of the lower oven on and off.
16 LOWER CLEAR/OFF	Use to stop cooking, cancel settings of the lower oven.
17 CONV. BAKE	Use to select the Convection Bake function of the lower oven.
18 CONV. ROAST	Use to select the Convection Roast function of the lower oven.
19 CRISP CONV.	Use to select the Crisp Convection function of the lower oven.
20 WARM/PROOF	Use to select the Warm/Proof function of the lower oven.
21 SELF CLEAN	Use to select the Self Clean function of the lower oven.

Name	Description
27 SETTING	Access and adjust oven settings. See pages 14 and 15.
28 CLOCK	Use to set the time of day.
	Use to set the length of the cook time. (Bake, Conv. Bake/Roast only)
30 START TIME	Use to set delay time. (Bake, Conv. Bake/Roast, Self Clean only)
31 NUMBER PADS	Use to enter a temperature and all times.
3 START	Use to START all functions in the oven. To activate OVEN LOCK press and hold for 3 seconds.
33 SMART FEATURES	The Tag On icon, for use with Smart Features.
3 SMART DIAGNOSIS™	Use with the Smart Diagnosis feature.

If F- and a number appear in the display and the oven control signals, this indicates a function error code. See page 38.

- Touch the UPPER or LOWER CLEAR/OFF pad.
- Allow the oven to cool for one hour. Put the oven back into operation.
- If the function error code repeats, disconnect the power to the oven and call for service.
- If your oven was set for a timed oven operation and a power outage occurred, the clock and all programmed functions must be reset.
- The time of day will flash in the display when there has been a power outage.
