Control panel features

Operation

Button	Description
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER ON/OFF BUTTON - Press to turn the dryer ON or OFF. Pressing the POWER button during a cycle will cancel that cycle and any settings will be lost.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CYCLE SELECTOR KNOB - Turn this knob to select the desired cycle. Once the desired cycle has been selected, the standard presets will be shown in the display. On MANUAL DRY cycles, these settings can be adjusted using the cycle setting buttons anytime before starting the cycle.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> START/PAUSE BUTTON - Press this button to START the selected cycle. If the dryer is running, use this button to PAUSE the cycle without losing the current settings. NOTE: If you do not press the START/PAUSE button to resume a cycle within 4 minutes, the dryer turns off automatically.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MORE TIME/LESS TIME BUTTONS - To adjust the drying time, use these buttons with MANUAL DRY, TIME DRY, and STEAM FRESH™ cycles, as well as the REDUCE STATIC and EASY IRON options. Press the MORE TIME button to increase the selected manual cycle time by a minute; press LESS TIME to decrease the cycle time by a minute.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CYCLE SETTING BUTTONS - Use these buttons to adjust the settings for the selected cycle.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> OPTION BUTTONS - The OPTION buttons allow you to select additional cycle options. Not all settings are available for all cycles. Refer to the CYCLE GUIDE section of the manual.
STEAM SANITARY™ STEAM FRESH™	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> STEAM FUNCTIONS - LG's steam technology allows you to inject fabrics with a swirling jet of hot steam to refresh clothes, reduce static, and make ironing easier. Simply select the STEAM FRESH™ cycle, or add a STEAM option to the selected cycles.

Time and status display

Time and status display shows the settings, estimated time remaining, options, and status messages for your dryer. When the dryer is turned on, the light in the display will illuminate.



Button	Description
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ESTIMATED TIME REMAINING <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - When the START/PAUSE button is pressed, the dryer will display the estimated (SENSOR DRY) or set time (TIME DRY) remaining, and begin tumbling. NOTE: The cycle time on SENSOR DRY cycles may fluctuate as the dryer recalculates drying time for optimal results.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CYCLE COMPLETION INDICATOR WITH CHECK FILTER REMINDER <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This portion of the display shows which stage of the drying cycle is currently underway (CHECK FILTER, DRYING, COOLING, or WRINKLE CARE).
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CHILD LOCK INDICATOR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - When CHILD LOCK is set, the CHILD LOCK indicator will appear and all buttons are disabled except the POWER button. This prevents children from changing settings while the dryer is operating.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CHECK FILTER LIGHT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - When the dryer is turned on, this light flashes as a reminder that the lint filter must be cleaned for each load. The light goes out when the cycle is started.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CUSTOM PROGRAM <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Custom Program allows you to store a customized dry cycle for future use. It allows you to save favorite temperature, dry level, and other options for a cycle, and then recall them at the touch of a button.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FLOW SENSE LIGHT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This light does not indicate a problem with your dryer, but rather a restriction in your home exhaust system. This issue can be easily fixed without calling for service. Please check for the following conditions if the Flow Sense light is lit or you are experiencing longer than usual dry times: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Make sure that the exhaust connecting to the dryer is not kinked. - Make sure that the dryer duct is clean and free of buildup: one way to check if the exhaust is clogged, is to start the dryer on a normal cycle, go outside where the dryer is vented and check the airflow. If there is no airflow or if the airflow is weak, then you may have a restriction (lint buildup) that needs to be removed. <p>Using the dryer while the "Flow Sense" light is on may create an unsafe environment.</p>
