





Setting Up the Canopy

1 OPENING THE CANOPY FRAME


 With a person on each end, lift and partially pull the canopy frame (C) apart.






2 ATTACHING THE SMALL CANOPY

 Position the small canopy (B) on the center of the frame (C) and hook the four corners of the small canopy (B) to the four hooks on the center structure of the frame (C).




3 ATTACHING THE LARGE CANOPY

- Unfold the large canopy (A) and place on top of the canopy frame (C). Ensure that you separate the large canopy (A) from the small canopy (B).
- Secure the large canopy (A) to the corners of the canopy frame (C) using the Velcro connections.




4 LOCKING THE CANOPY

 From under the canopy, place one hand on the upper frame and use the other hand to push the central hub straight up until it clicks into the central pole. Finish attaching the large canopy (A) inside the canopy frame using the Velcro loops.




5 ATTACHING THE SIDEWALL

- $\hfill\Box$ Hook the top two corners of the side wall (F) onto the metal loops on the canopy frame.
- Connect the velcro loops around the frame to secure the side wall (F) in place.



6 ADJUSTING THE CANOPY HEIGHT

 $\hfill\Box$ Press the red button on each leg and raise or lower to adjust the canopy height.



7 SECURING THE CANOPY IN PLACE

- □ Insert a stake (D) into the foot of each canopy leg.
- Measure out from the each leg to a proper distance and secure four stakes (D) to the ground. Tie the pre-attached ropes to the stakes (D) on the ground. Ensure the rope has the proper tension by adjusting the plastic adjusters on the ropes.






Taking Down the Canopy


1 REMOVING THE STAKES AND SHORTENING THE LEGS

- Pull up all stakes (D) from the ground.
- Press the push button on each leg and shorten the legs to their original height.



2 COLLAPSING THE CANOPY

 From underneath the canopy, press in the red lock button. Pull down on the central hub until it is separated from the central pole.



3 FOLDING THE FRAME


 Lift one corner of the frame until all legs are raised off the ground except for the 1 leg on the opposite corner. Push inward until the frame is fully closed.






PACKING THE CANOPY IN THE STORAGE BAG

- With the canopy feet facing the rollers, slide the wheeled storage bag (G) over the closed canopy frame.
- Close the zipper on the wheeled storage bag (G).




