



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


STEP 1

Lay WOOD TOP FRAME (A) on a clean surface to prevent scratching the top surface. Take HANDLE LEG (D) and orient it in the proper position by aligning the hole for mounting the handle along the long edge of the WOOD TOP FRAME (A)

Place LEG SCREW (G) through hole in WOOD TOP FRAME (A) and tighten it with SCREWDRIVER (I) to the top nut in HANDLE LEG (D).

Repeat for the other HANDLE LEG (D).


Please note that the HANDLE LEG (D) has a FOOT PAD on the bottom.



STEP 2


Place HANDLE SCREW (H) through hole in the HANDLE LEG (D) and tighten it with SCREWDRIVER (I) to the nut in the HANDLE (E).

Repeat for the other side.


STEP 3




STEP 4

Place LEG SCREW (G) through hole in the WOOD TOP (A) or HANDLE LEG (D) and tighten it with SCREWDRIVER (I) to nut in CASTER LEG (C).

Repeat until all 6 LEG SCREWS (G) have been installed.







ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5

Flip cart over and lay WOOD TOP FRAME (A) top surface on a clean surface again. Screw CASTER (F) into the nut at the bottom of CASTER LEG (C). Tighten CASTER (F) with WRENCH (J).

<u>Use the provided caster wrench to</u> <u>tighten completely.</u> Failure to do as <u>instructed could result in the caster</u> <u>stem breaking.</u>



STEP 6

Carefully flip completed cart right side up.



Place TRAY (K) onto SHELF (B).











- 4. Do NOT modify the product in any way. Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety of the product, and may affect the life of the product.
- 5. Check for damaged parts. Before using this product, carefully check that all parts are in good condition, and that the product will operate properly and perform its intended function. Check for damaged parts and any other conditions that may affect the operation of this product. Replace damaged or worn parts, and never use this product with a damaged part.

6. Do NOT overload the product.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Do NOT use a scouring pad for cleaning.
- Keep dry and avoid damp environments.
- Wood top can be cleaned with damp cloth and wiped dry immediately with dry cloth.
 If needed, solvent-based wood furniture cleaner can be used.
- Clean up any spills immediately to prevent stains from forming on the wood top.
- Do not let children climb or play on the cart.

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

TRINITY Wood Kitchen Cart Model # TBFLWH-1402 / 1403

Trinity International Industries ("Trinity") warrants to the original consumer purchaser ("Purchaser") of the TRINITY Wood Kitchen Cart ("Product") that each Product shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 1 year from the date of original purchase. Trinity's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or replacement of, or adequate compensation for the Product which shall not be greater than the amount of the purchase price of the Product, at the option of Trinity, during the warranty period. All replaced parts and Products become the property of Trinity and must be returned to Trinity.

This warranty excludes normal wear and tear of the Product and its parts or components, and damage arising from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the Product, use contrary to this User's Manual, or alteration by any one other than Trinity. The warranty period of 1 year shall not be extended or renewed by the repair or replacement of, or compensation for, the Product. Any warranty implied by applicable law is limited in duration to one year from the date of purchase and is subject to the same conditions and limitations as is provided for our express warranty.
