
Toilet Fit Guide




You'll need to measure your toilet to determine:

- Whether a Brondell Swash will fit (the Swash fits most residential toilets)
- Whether you need an Elongated or Round Swash







Measure the distance from the bolt holes to the front of the toilet bowl to determine if you have a **round** or **elongated** fixture.




If your measurement is $18" - 19\frac{1}{2}"$ Order an **Elongated Swash**



If your measurement is 16" – 17³/₄" Order a **Round Swash** Measure the distance from the center of the bolt holes to the toilet tank to determine proper clearance. There must be at least 1½ inches of clearance.



Is the distance from the center of the bolt holes to the toilet tank less than 2"?



If this measurement is less than $20\frac{1}{2}$ ", consider purchasing a Round shape to reduce the amount the seat extends over the front edge, even if your fixture is elongated.

The overall length of the Round Swash is 19.55". A distance less than 19.55" from the tank to the front of the toilet bowl will also cause overhang.
