



DANGER: Keep children out of the assembly area before assembly.

IMPORTANT: Check the tightness of all bolts at least once every 90 days.



IMPORTANT: Maintain the wood component with teak or linseed oil at least once every 30 days.

Warranty

2 YEAR FRAME AND 1 YEAR WOOD COMPONENT LIMITED WARRANTY

WHAT IS COVERED

We warrant the frame to be free of manufacturing defects to the original purchaser for two years and wood component for one year.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

It remains the customer's responsibility for freight and packaging charges to and from our service center. This warranty does not cover commercial use, hardware, acts of nature, fire, freezing and abusive use. In addition, purchased parts are not covered under this warranty. We reserve the right to make substitutions with similar merchandise, if the model in question is no longer in production.

Care Instructions

Before using, wipe with a clean, dry cloth. Do not use bleach or solvents. Treat the frame with liquid wax for maximum protection against UV light and salty, damp air. When not in use, store furniture in a cool, dry place. If the set includes cushions or mesh fabric, they may be cleaned by hand with a mild solution of soap and water. Rinse cushions thoroughly and allow to drip dry. Do not machine wash or tumble dry, as cushions may shrink. Do not use bleach or solvents on fabrics. When cleaning the chair make sure to use a soft clean cloth that does not bleed color.

ADDITIONAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR WOOD

Your patio furniture set contains natural, eucalyptus wood. If untreated, it will weather to a majestic, soft gray. However, it can be stained to maintain its rich tones. To maintain the new appearance, it is recommended to apply teak or linseed oil before you use, and occasionally throughout the season. For ideal care of your wood furniture, we recommend the following tips:

For daily care, wipe with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid the use of harsh cleaners and abrasives. Wipe spills immediately with a clean dry cloth. If there is a food stain or animal droppings wipe clean with a soft cloth and some warm water. Cover furniture with outdoor covers when left outside during inclement weather or when not in use. Please be sure you use a proper cover that allows for adequate ventilation without trapping moisture. In the off-season, store indoors.


Assembly

1 Attaching the seat to the left arm

- Attach the seat (D) to the left arm (A) by inserting bolts (AA) with metal washers (CC) through the two pre-drilled holes.



IMPORTANT: Do not tighten completely until assembly is completed.




2 Attaching the seat to the right arm

- Repeat step 1 to attach the right arm (B).



IMPORTANT: Do not tighten completely until assembly is completed.




Assembly (continued)

3 Attaching the back to the seat

- Insert the back (C) to the pre-drilled holes on the rear area of the seat (D).
- Attach the right arm (B) by inserting bolts (BB) with metal washers (CC) through the pre-drill holes on the arm into the back (C).
- Repeat for the left arm (A).




IMPORTANT: Do not tighten completely until assembly is completed.



4 Completing the assembly

- Tighten all bolts with the allen wrench (DD), and cover them with plastic bolt caps (EE). Place the seat cushion (E) on the chair and attach with velcro ties. Your chair is now ready for use, so relax & enjoy!
