

# BRONZE WOOL USES



## Why is it different than steel wool?

- Bronze Wool **resists shedding, rust and corrosion**
- Cuts better and faster than sandpaper and other abrasives (**not as “scratchy”**)
- **Will not discolor materials** such as oak and steel

## Bronze Wool and Marine Applications

- **Superior refinishing** results with hardwoods such as teak
- **Resists shedding, rust and corrosion** essential traits in marine environment
- **Does not have magnetic properties** which can affect the operation of marine equipment

## Typical uses for Bronze Wool on boats

- Stripping old varnish
- Burnishing bottom paint
- Smoothing raised grain
- Buffing teak trim, decks, swim platforms, etc.
- Polishing chrome accessories

## Other uses include

- Cleaning aluminum outdoor furniture
- Removing rust from metal surfaces
- Polishing brass and stainless steel
