Why is it different than steel wool?

- Bronze Wool resists shedding, rust and corrosion
- Cuts better and faster than sandpaper and other abrasives (not as "scratchy")
- Will not discolor materials such as oak and steel

Bronze Wool and Marine Applications

- Superior refinishing results with hardwoods such as teak
- Resists shedding, rust and corrosion essential traits in marine environment
- Does not have magnetic properties which can affect the operation of marine equipment

Typical uses for Bronze Wool on boats

- Stripping old varnish
- Burnishing bottom paint
- Smoothing raised grain
- Buffing teak trim, decks, swim platforms, etc.
- Polishing chrome accessories

Other uses include

- Cleaning aluminum outdoor furniture
- Removing rust from metal surfaces
- Polishing brass and stainless steel
