

Some Common Soil types

- 1. Coarse river sand.
- 2. Fine, coastal sand often contains fragments of shells making it slightly alkaline.
- 3. Sandy loam.
- 4. Loam with minor red clay content.
- 5. Red soil, rich in iron oxide.
- 6. Good loamy soil with high humus content.
- 7. Dark, clay soil.
