

please carefully take all of the parts out of the box and lay then on a flat surface to verify than you have all of the parts.


Before assembling, make sure your area is large enough to unpack, sort and assemble the unit.





Assembly


Step 1 - Figure 1

- □ Take Headboard (A) connect with Headboard Legs (D), use Sunk Bolts (AA) tighten by Allen Wrench (II).
- □ Take Cross Bar (H) with Headboard Legs (D), use Allen Bolts (BB) tighten by Allen Wrench (II).



2 Step 2 - Figure 2


□ Take Footboard (B) and Footboard Legs (E), use Sunk Bolts (AA) tighten by Allen Wrench (II).



Assembly (continued)


3 Step 3 - Figure 3

□ Side Rails (K) screw with Headboard Legs (D), use Allen Bolts (BB), Metal Washers (GG), Spring Washers (FF) and Hex Nuts (HH) with Allen Wrench (II) and Open Wrench (JJ) tighten together.



4 Step 4 - Figure 4

□ Side Rails (K) screw with Footboard Legs (E), use Allen Bolts (DD), Spring Washers (FF) and Metal Washers (GG) with Allen Wrench (II) tighten together.






5 Step 5 - Figure 5

- □ Short Canopy Posts (F) lock with Headboard Legs (D).
- □ Long Canopy Posts (G) lock with Footboard Legs (E).

6 Step 6 - Figure 6

□ Long Canopy Poles (J) lock with
Short Canopy posts & Long Canopy Posts (F & G).
Use Finials (C) tighten together.




7 Step 7 - Figure 7

□ Insert Support Legs (M) to Metal Slats (L) with Allen Bolts (EE), use Allen Wrench (II) tighten together.



8 Step 8 - Figure 8

□ Metal Slats (L) connect with Side Rails (K), use Allen Bolts (CC), Metal Washers (GG) and Hex Nuts (HH) tighten with Allen Wrench (II) and Open Wrench (JJ).



Maintenance

- □ Keep the product away from direct heat and sunlight.
- □ Prolonged exposure to heat sources may cause glazing, melting and scorching, or even cause color to fade.
- □ Regular vacuuming or light brushing helps to remove dirt and prevent soil build-up, which increases the appearance wear.
- □ Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws are fully tightened.

Care and Cleaning

- □ Vacuum your product regularly. Small dust particles are very abrasive and can wear furniture prematurely.
- □ Clean spills immediately to prevent staining. If necessary, gently wipe away the spill using a soft, clean cloth dampened with lukewarm water. Allow to dry and brush lightly.
- □ Never use harsh chemicals or solvents on your product as this may damage the fabric.
- □ If you choose to use a professional product, pretest the fabric in an inconspicuous area for any signs of discoloration or shrinking.
- □ Marks and stains from pens, crayons and ink markers are difficult to remove. In the event that your product becomes permanently stained, we recommend that you consult a professional.
