

To avoid damaging this product, assemble it on a soft, non-abrasive surface such as carpet or cardboard.







# **Assembly**


## Attaching the table legs to the table top

- □ Place the table top (A) upside down on a soft surface.
- Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) using M8x90 hex combination bolts (AA), the metal sheets (BB) and the wrench (CC).



# **2** Removing the adjustable feet from the table legs

□ Remove the adjustable feet (EE) from the table legs (B) by rotating in the counterclockwise direction.




# 3 Inserting the long bolts into the table legs and the table top

- Ensure the table legs (B) are correctly aligned with the corners of the table top (A).
- □ Insert the long bolts (C) through the M8 washers (DD) and into the table legs (B).
- Attach the long bolts (C) to the table top (A) using the wrench (CC).




NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the wrench (CC).


## Tightening the bolts and attaching the adjustable feet to the table legs

- Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts.
- □ Attach the adjustable feet (EE) to the table legs (B) by rotating in the clockwise direction.



# **5** Checking the table

- □ Turn the table right side up.
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.



## **Care and Cleaning**

- □ For best results, clean the frame and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- □ Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the table in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- □ Keep the table away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
