 A 2000 watt generator can weigh up to 50 lbs, making it easy for one person to carry alone. Compare that to a single 4000 watt generator that weighs almost 100 lbs.
- 3 Two generators with Parallel Ports give you more flexibility Use just one generator when light duty power is needed, or tether the two generators together when you need heavy duty power.



- 4 Having two generators provides you with a backup if one runs out of fuel Be prepared in an emergency have two small portable generators on hand instead of one heavy generator, in case one runs out of unleaded gas.
- Inverter generators provide stable, clean power
 Inverter generators provide sine wave power, which is a more
 refined, stable electrical output for your home and RV electronics.
 They are also quieter and more fuel efficient than other generators.
