





Installation

Installing the center rods




WARNING: Turn off power at the main fuse box.


- □ Carefully unpack the fixture. Lay out all the parts on a clean surface.
- Unfold the fixture arms, as shown below.
- Unravel the supply power and ground wires and pass them through the center hole of the rod (B), (C), (D), (E), and canopy (F).
- Install center rods (B), (C), (D), (E), and the canopy (F) by twisting each piece clockwise as the figure shows.



- NOTE: Always use the wire nuts (AA) to connect wires and push all excess wires and connections back into the canopy (F).
- □ Connect the red wire of the driver to the red wire of the fixture and connect the blue wire of the driver to the blue wire of the fixture.



□ Connect the fixture wires as follows.







Installing the universal crossbar



Secure the universal crossbar (EE) to the junction box (not included) with the two outlet box screws (BB).






Installation (continued)




NOTE: Always use the wire nuts (AA) to connect wires and push all excess wires and connections back into the junction box (not included).

 Connect the ground wire from the branch circuit to the ground screw (CC) on the universal crossbar (EE).




Connect the fixture wires as follows.




5 Installing the canopy

 Install the canopy (F) in the universal crossbar (EE) with mounting screws (DD).



6 Installing the glass

With reference to the line drawing, install the small glass (G) and large glass (H) to the fixture body (A) and twist clockwise to secure in place.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The bulb will not light.	The bulb is burned out.	Replace the light bulb.
	□ The power is off.	 Ensure that the power supply is turned on.
	□ The circuit breaker is off.	 Ensure that the circuit breaker is set to the ON position.
The fuse blows or the circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	 There are too many items on one circuit. 	 Unplug the other items on the circuit. Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-800-986-3460.
