

# Decoration Panels Installation Instruction

## Barn Wood Wall Art

### **WARNING:**

Cutting, sanding or machining wood products produces wood dust. While wood products are not hazardous under OSHA Hazard Communication Standard (29CFR 1910.1200), the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) and the State of California has classified wood dust as a human carcinogen.

### **EXPECT THE NATURAL VARIATION OF WOOD:**

All our wall panels are designed to highlight the natural variation of wood on structure and in color. Each wood piece is different, but all together they create an ensure consistency of the final product visual. Sunlight or intense artificial lighting can cause color changes.

### **STRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS:**

The strong picture holders are required to place Decoration Panels on the wall. The weight of each panel itself is approx. 2 lbs.

### **FIREPLACES & HEATERS:**

NOT recommended the use of Barn Wood wall panels around an open "flame" places. The Panels are made from the wood which is flammable material.

### **BATHROOMS:**

Barn Wood Panels may be used in bathrooms as long as they are NOT installed at high splash areas.

### **CEILINGS APPLICATIONS:**

Ceilings applications are not recommended as the Panels are designed for walls.

### **TOOLS AND SUPPLIES FOR INSTALLATION:**

Assemble all your tools and supplies before you begin the job. Here is what you will need for most common wall paneling installations:

- Tape measure
- Hammer
- Picture hangers

### **PANELS MEASUREMENTS:**

Thickness: 1/2 in.

Width: 15.75 in.

Length: 15.00 in.

One panel in a box.




**CARE AND MAINTENANCE:**

It is recommended to use a vacuum to clean panels if needed.

Wood is a natural organic material, which might be fading under direct sunlight and any bright light. To protect natural wood against color degradation, use standard wood oil or lacker with UV protection. Spray it to the surface. Wood will appear darker when it oiled.

# Installation Steps

## Hollywood Wall Art Panels

Steps	Drawing
<p><b>1.</b> Use vertical installation orientation for easy hook to the wall. If use horizontal orientation attach any picture hanger or string to the back of the panel (not included):</p>	
<p><b>2.</b> Install picture hangers on the wall (any model similar to the shown at the pictures).</p>	
<p><b>3.</b> Place the cross plank on the back of the Panel against the hook. Be sure that the panel is sitting well.</p>
