### WARNING, SAFETY, & MAINTENANCE

Do not allow children or minors to play on or around this equipment.

### **PREPARATION**

Thank you for purchasing the **BFMC10**. This machine is part of the Best Fitness line of quality strength training machines, which lets you target specific muscle groups to achieve better muscle tone and overall body conditioning. To maximize your use of the equipment please study this Owner's Manual thoroughly.

#### **Required Tools**

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the BFMC10 include but are not limited to:

- Metric Allen Key Set
- Standard Allen Key Set
- Standard Wrench Set
- Metric Wrench Set
- Adjustable Wrench
- Screwdriver (standard and/or phillips)

#### **Installation Requirements**

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the BFMC10:

Set up the **BFMC10** on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flat surface under the machine helps keep it level. A level machine has fewer malfunctions.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

Insert all bolts in the same direction. For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

Fill out and mail the warranty card.

#### **Assembly Tips**

Read all "Notes" on each page before beginning each

While you may be able to assemble the **BFMC10** using the illustrations only, important safety notes and other tips are included in the text.

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

NOTE: With so many assembled parts, proper


alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave

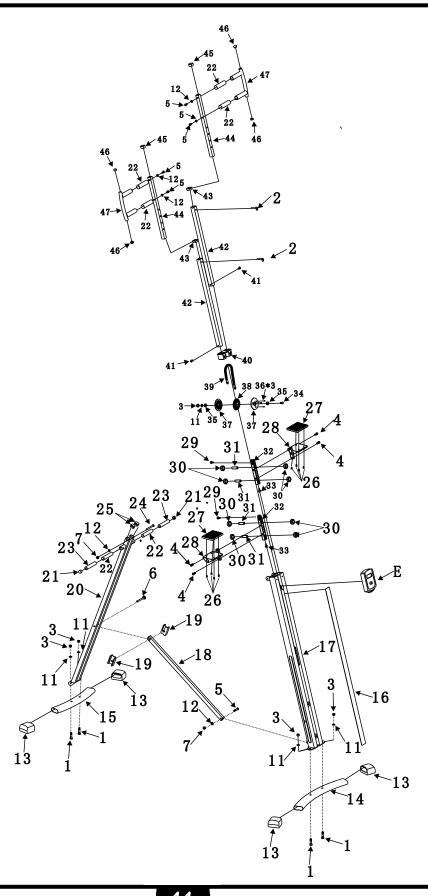

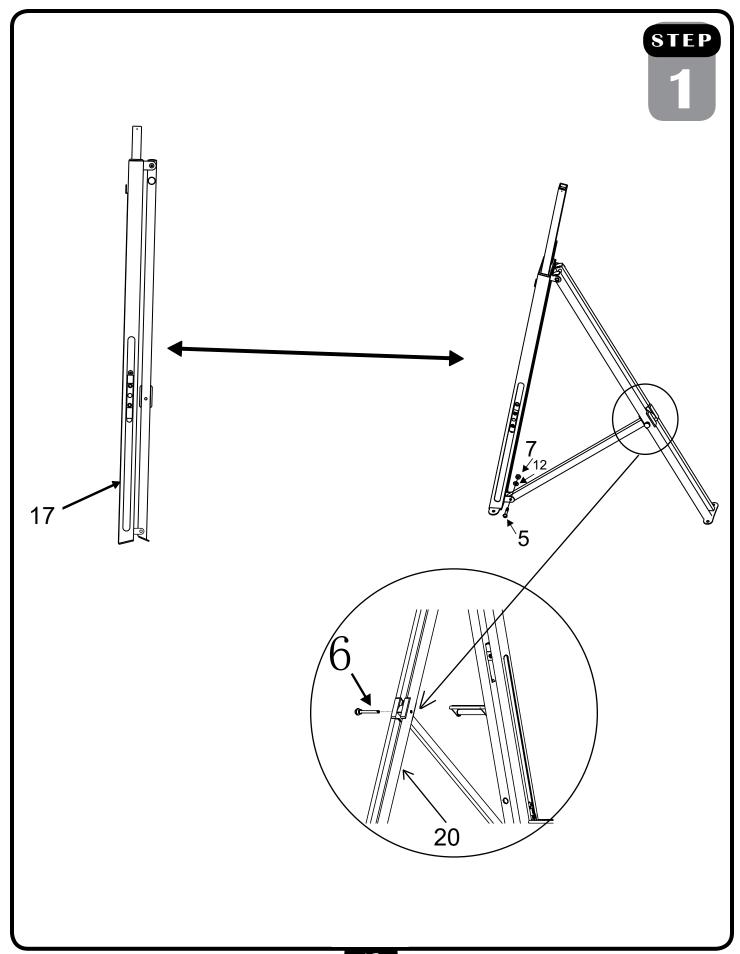
Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 1B. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 1A. Unfold the Main Frame (#17) as shown in the STEP 1 Drawing.
- 1B. Attach the Middle Crossmember to the Main Frame using:

(#5) M8X35mm Button Head Cap Screw, QTY: 1

(#7) M8 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY: 1 (#12) M8 Flat Washer, QTY: 1

1C. Insert the Ball Head Pop Pin (#6) into the Rear Frame (#20).

### **NOTE:**

Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 2A. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

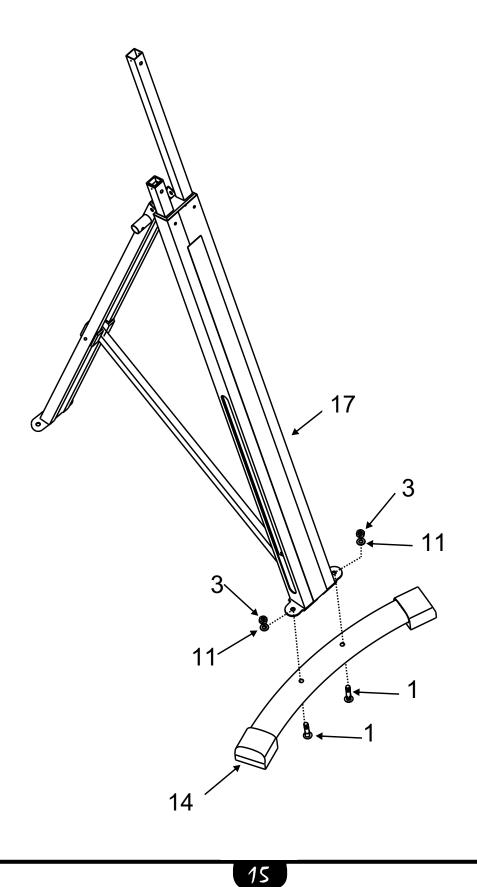
### 2A. Attach Front Stabilizer (#14) to Main Frame (#17) using:

(#1) M10X40mm Carriage Bolt, QTY: 2

(#3) M10 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY: 2 (#11) M10 Flat Washer, QTY: 2

NOTE: Front Stabilizer (#14) is longer than Rear Stabilizer (#15).

Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP **3A**. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

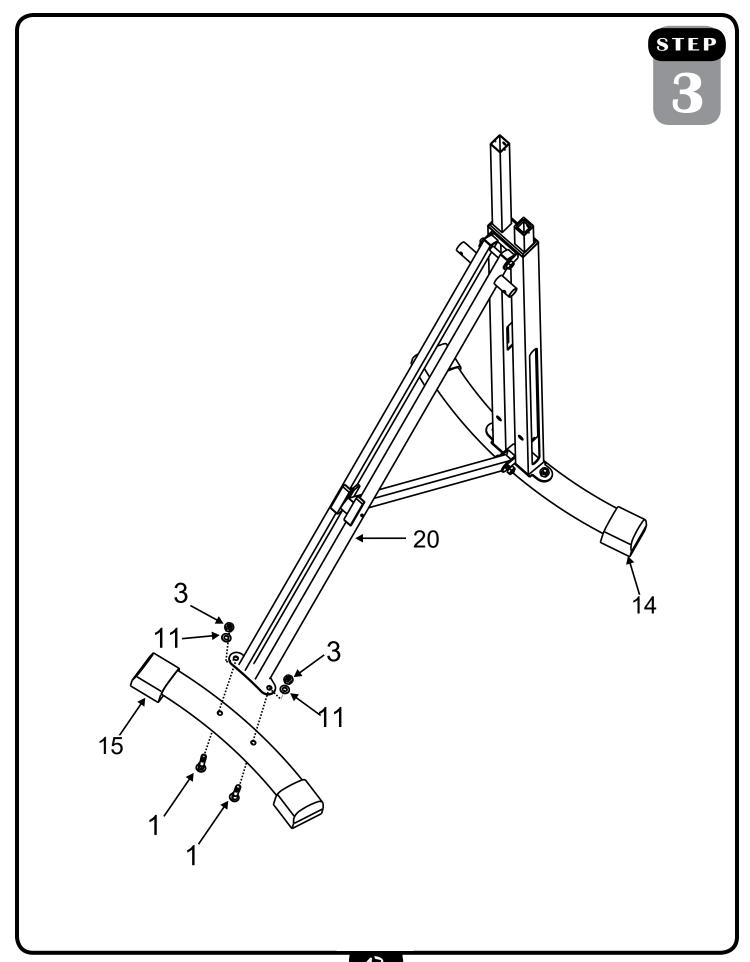
3A. Attach Rear Stabilizer (#15) to Rear Frame (20) using:

(#1) M10X40mm Carriage Bolt, QTY: 2

(#3) M10 Nylon Lock Nut, QTY: 2

(#11) M10 Flat Washer, QTY: 2

NOTE: Front Stabilizer (#14) is longer than Rear Stabilizer (#15).





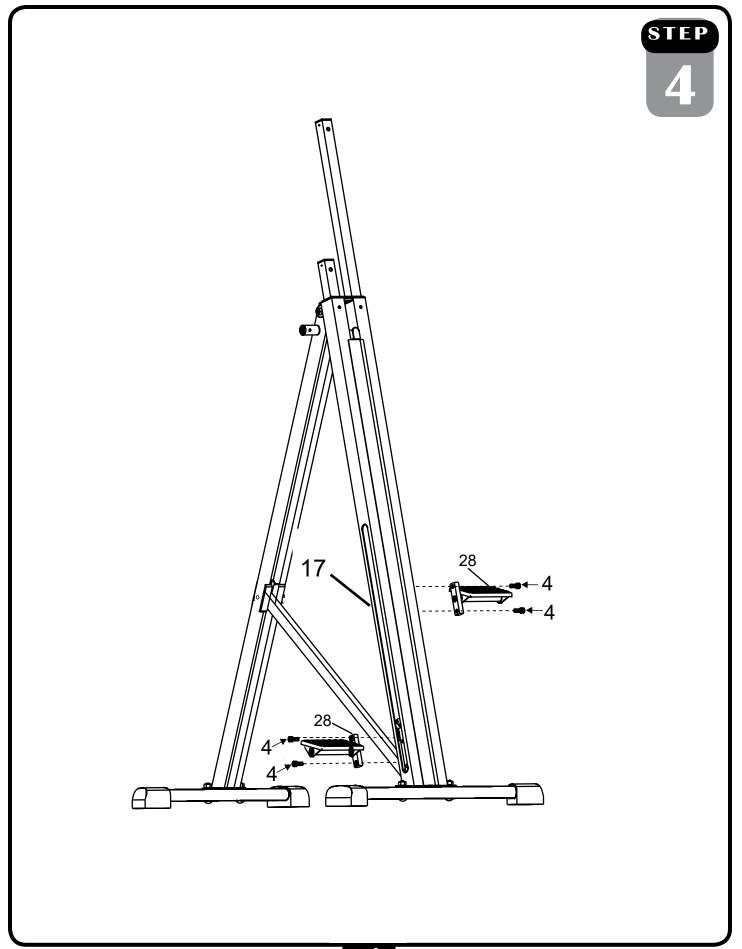

Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 4A. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

4A. Attach two Foot Pedals (#28) to Main Frame (#17) using: (#4) M8X20mm Socket Head Cap Screw, QTY: 4

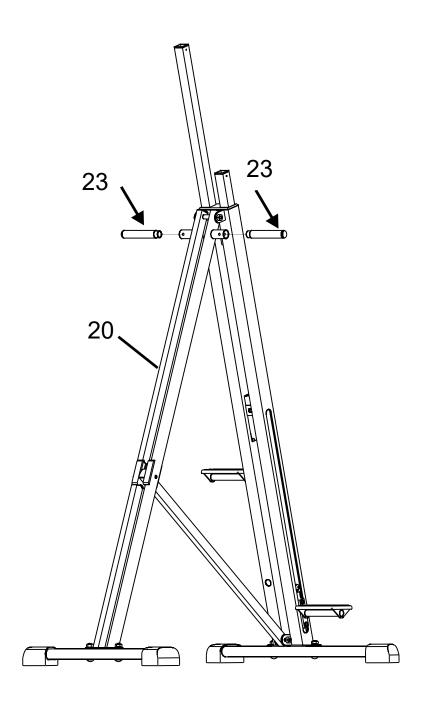

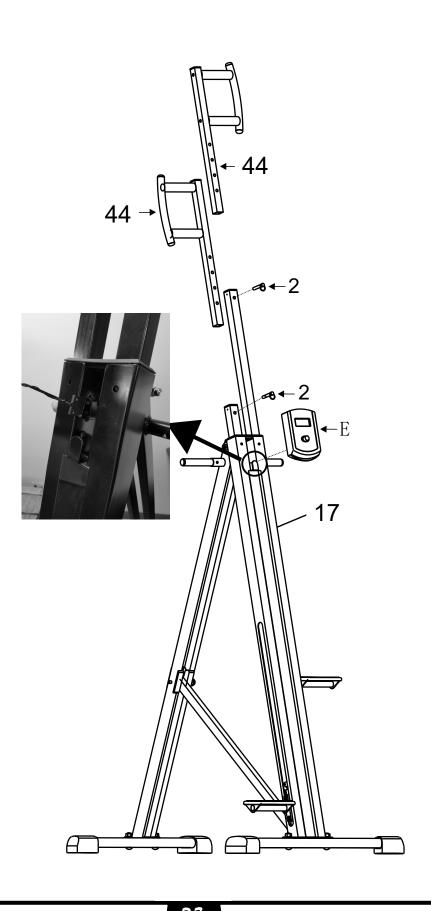

- 6A. Insert two Top Handlebar Tubes (#44) into the Main Frame (#17) and secure the Handlebar Tubes (#44) with Pop Pins (#2).
- 6B. Insert the sensor of the Workout Monitor (E) into the bracket of Main Frame (#17) as shown in the Photo.
- 6C. Attach Workout Monitor (E) on the Main Frame (#17).

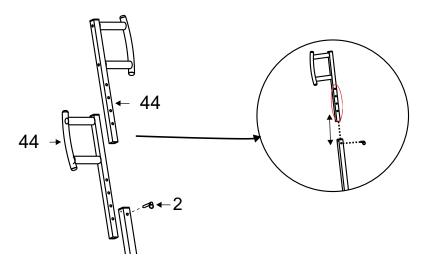




### **SETTING UP YOUR BFMC10**

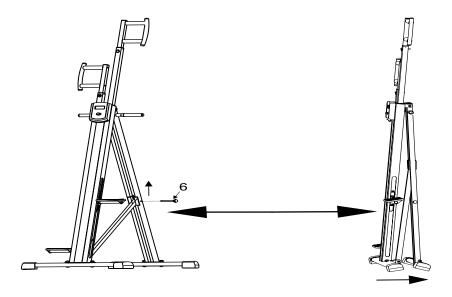
### **HEIGHT ADJUSTMENTS**

There are five different height adjustment settings. Pull out the Pop Pins (#2) and move the Handles (D) to the desired height. Insert the Pop Pins (#2) back secure the handles (D)



### **FOLDING AND STORAGE**

To fold the machine, remove the safety Pin (#6) and push the Frames together to fold.



### **WORKOUT MONITOR OPERATION**

### MONITOR DISPLAY

The display shows TIME, STEP COUNT, CALORIES, TOTAL STEP COUNT and RPM.

#### POWER ON/OFF:

- The Monitor will turn on when the button is pressed or it detects motion.
- The monitor will turn off when the sensor does not detect any motion or no key is pressed for 4 minutes.

#### **CONSOLE OPERATION:**

- When the monitor is on, and the "SCAN" symbol on the left bottom corner is flashing on the display, It will alternate to display TIME, STEP COUNT, CALORIES, TOTAL STEP COUNT and RPM each for 3 seconds.
- "SCAN" mode can be cancelled by pressing the button once. The user can choose to display TIME, STEP COUNT, CALORIES, TOTAL STEP, COUNT or RPM by pressing the button.

#### **RESET:**

- The monitor can be reset by press and hold the button for 3 seconds.

#### **BATTERY:**

- The monitor uses two "AAA" batteriers. The Battery Compartment is on the back of the monitor.
