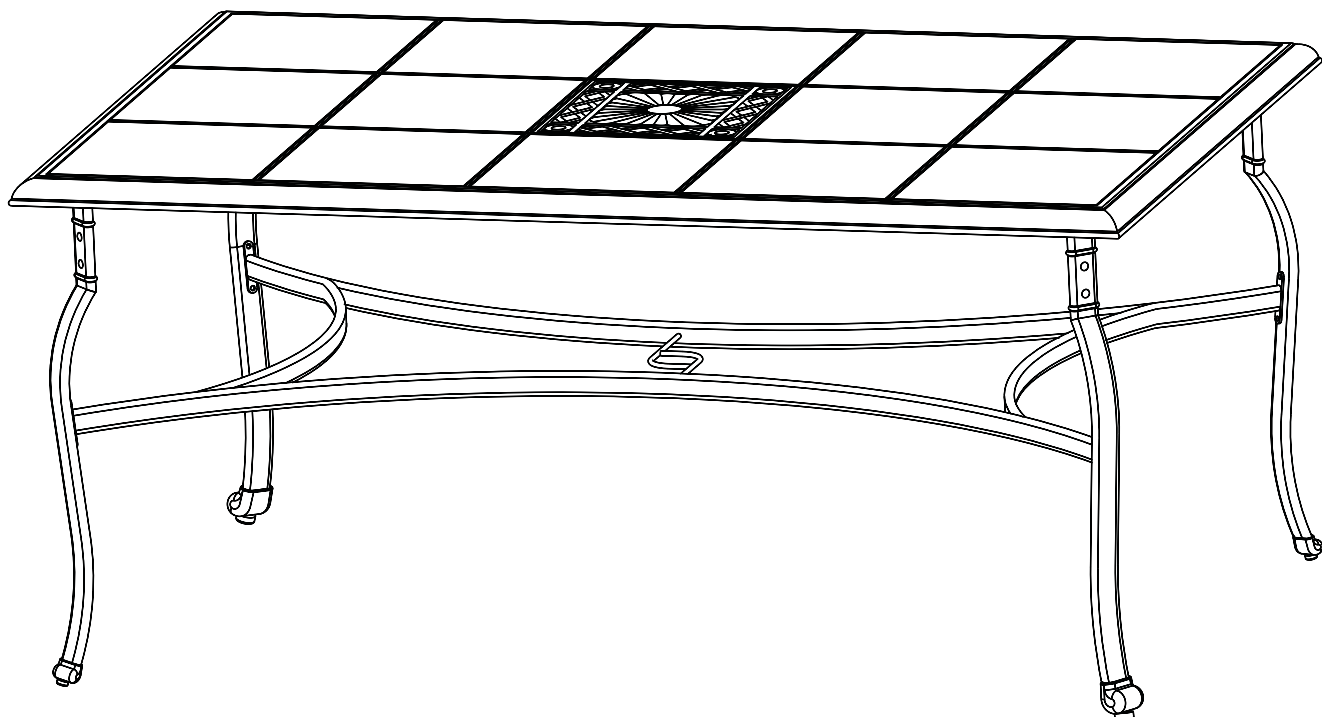

To avoid damaging this product, assemble it on a soft, non-abrasive surface such as carpet or cardboard.

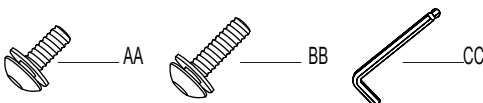

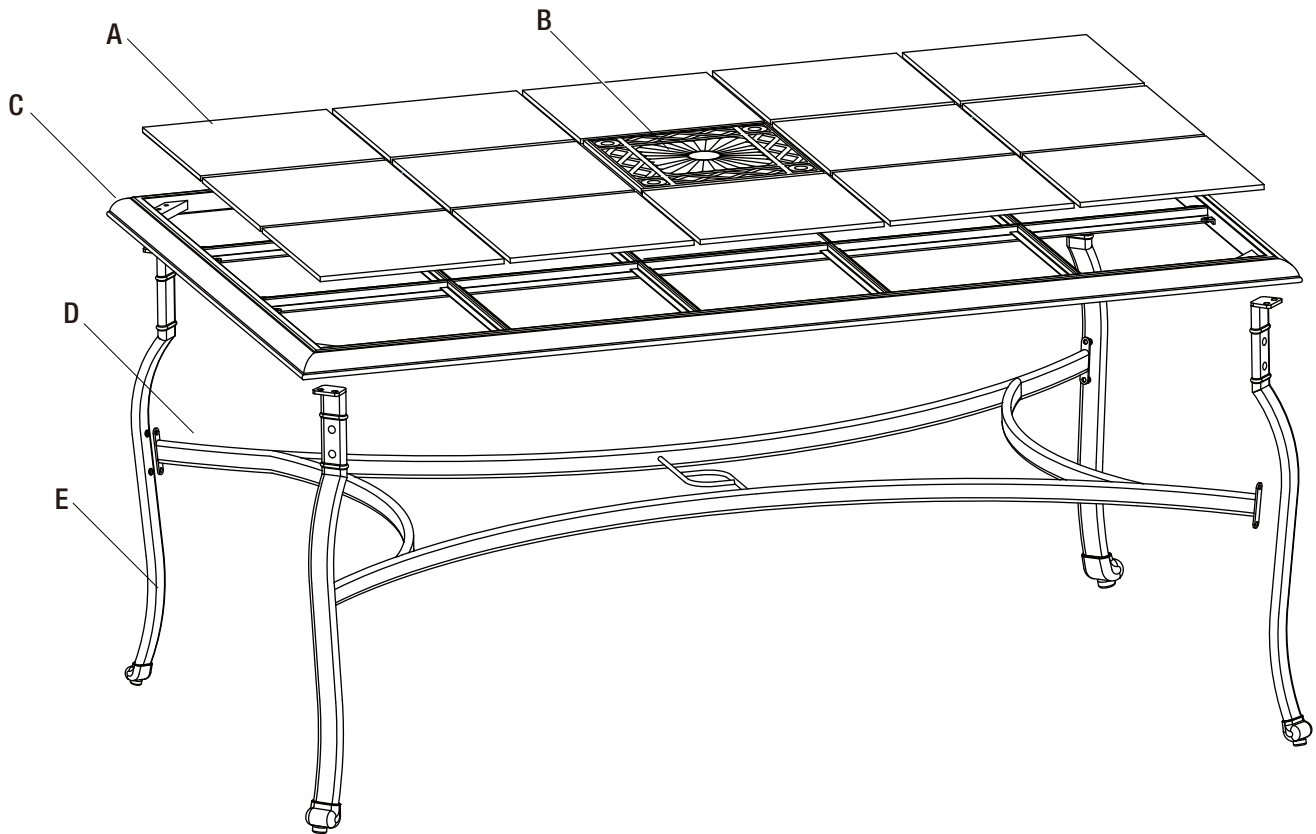

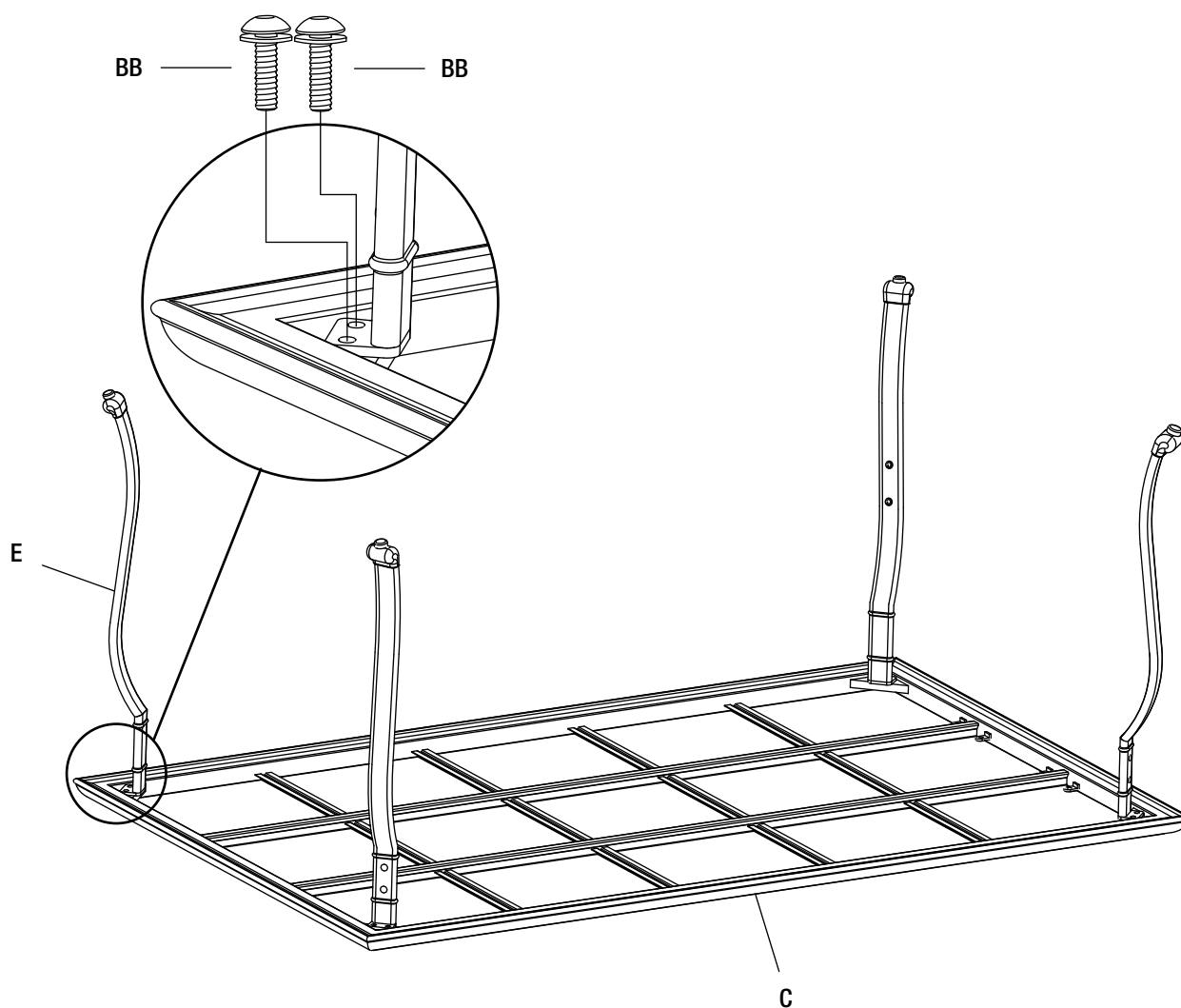
# Assembly

## 1 Connecting the table leg

- Place the table rim (C) upside down on a soft surface.
- Connect each of the table legs (E) with M6x20 combination bolts (BB) to the table rim (C).



**NOTE:** Loosely tighten the bolts using the hex wrench (CC).



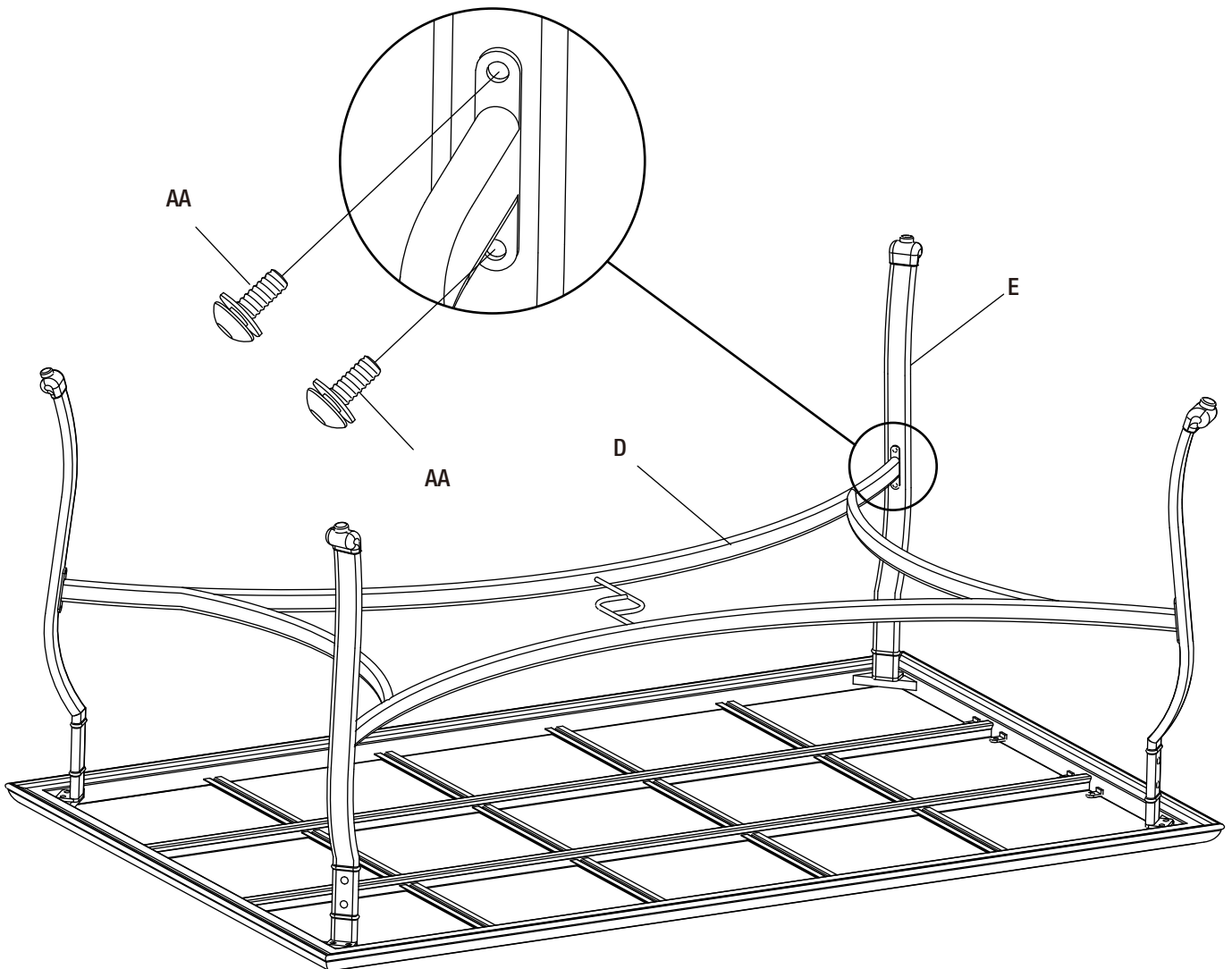
# Assembly (continued)

## 2 Connecting the leg connector to the table legs

- Align the holes of the leg connector (D) with the holes on the inside of each the table leg (E).
- Connect the leg connector (D) to the table legs (E) with M6x15 combination bolts (AA).
- Tighten all the bolts.



**NOTE:** Tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (CC).



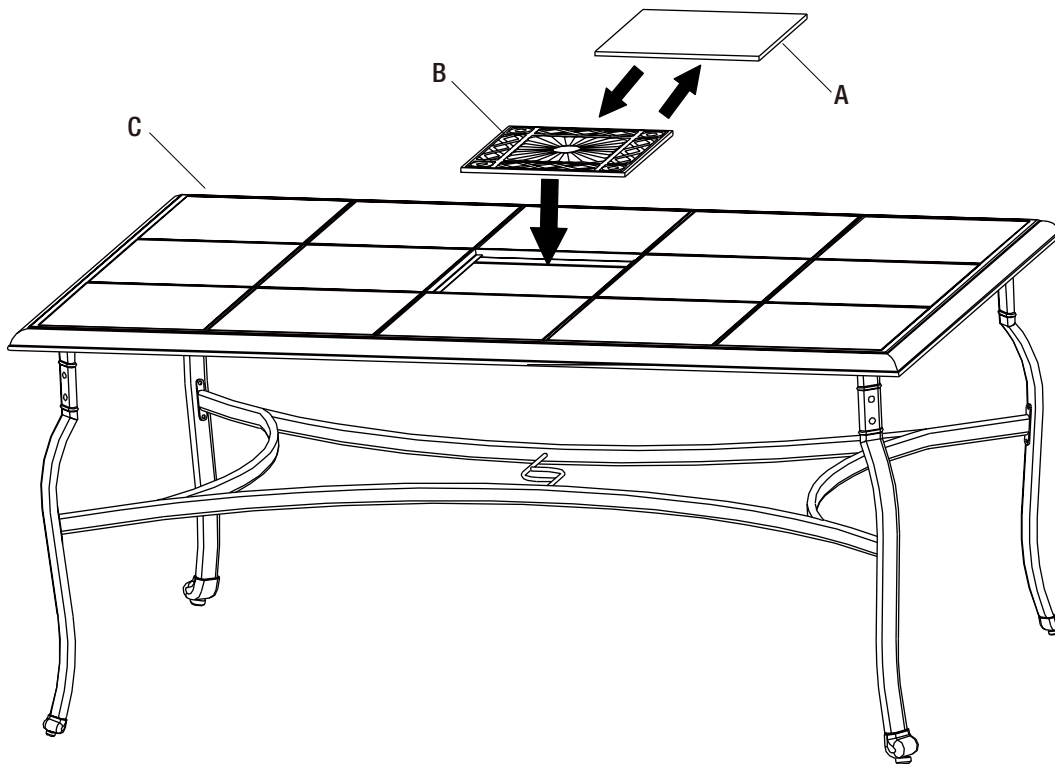
## Assembly (continued)

### 3 Adding the tiles

- Turn the table right side up.
- Ensure all connections are secure.
- Carefully place the tiles (A) and stamped metal (B) onto the table rim (C).



**NOTE:** The stamped metal (B) can be replaced by the tile (A) if desired.



## Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the frame with damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the dining table in a dry sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the dining table out of fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.



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Retain this manual for future use.
