



Use and Care Guide
Ethernet and Coax Wall Plate

## Installation

- Remove the old wall plate from the wall outlet box.
- If necessary, trim the cable jacket back about 2 in., being careful not to nick any wires inside.
- If necessary, strip about ½ in. of insulation off each wire.
- For the Ethernet connections, attach each wire to the specific terminal listed in the chart below. Note that most residential networks use the T-568B Standard.
- For the Coaxial connection, connect the coaxial cable to the "F" connector on the back of the new wall plate.
- Attach the wall plate to the wall using the two screws located on the back of the wall plate.
