

To avoid damaging this product, assemble it on a soft, non-abrasive surface such as carpet or cardboard.







Assembly

1 Opening the panels

Open the four panels (B).




2 Securing the corner connectors

- □ Secure the corner connector 1 (F) and the corner connector 2 (G) to the top corners of the panel (B) using M6x12 combination bolts (AA).
- □ Repeat this step for the other corner connectors.



NOTE: Fully tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).




3 Attaching the track tubes

- Insert the track tube (C) into the track tube connector (H), and secure the assembled part to the beam (A) using M6x30 combination bolts (BB).
- □ Insert an M6x35 combination bolt (CC) through the track tube (C), the plastic washer (FF), and secure to the beam (A) using the hex wrench (EE).
- Repeat this step for the other track tubes.



NOTE: Fully tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).

Connecting the panels and the beams


- □ Insert the beam (A) into the panel (B). Secure the beam (A) and the panel (B) using an M6x30 combination bolt (BB).
- □ Repeat above step for the other panels and the beams.



NOTE 1: Place the track tubes (C) toward the inside to assemble the netting correctly.




NOTE 2: More than two people are required to assemble this step.



5 Attaching the canopy spokes to the canopy hub and the beams

- Insert the long tube of the canopy spokes (D) into the canopy hub (E).
- □ Insert the other side of the long tube of the canopy spokes (D) into the corner connectors (F & G), as shown below.





Attaching the large fabric cover

□ Place the large fabric cover (K) onto the assembled frame.




NOTE: Do not fully extend the fabric cover.




7 Attaching the small fabric cover

Place the small fabric cover (J) and secure each corner by fully extending the fabric to the assembled short tubes of the canopy spokes (D).




8 Tying the large fabric cover to the beams and the panels

□ Fully extend the large fabric cover (K) and tie it to the beams (A) and the panels (B) by affixing the Velcro.



9 Hanging the netting and securing the panels to the ground

- Hang the netting (I) to the panels (B) and the track tubes (C) by using the Q-shape plastic rings (L).
- Secure the panels (B) to the ground using the ground spikes (DD).
- Ensure the ground spikes are inserted fully into the ground and all the connections are secure before use.



- For best results, clean the gazebo with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the gazebo in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the gazebo away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
