-WARNING- **COMBINED SET & BED**

Note:

- It is important to read the instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- Accurately identify the parts and hardware.
- We recommend assembling the product on a carpet to avoid scratching it.
- Easy assembly **REQUIRED 2 PEOPLE**

Size of mattress and foundation

The only acceptable size for a mattress to be used with this COMBINED UNIT is as follows:

- 1- The mattress must be between 37.5 and 38.5 inches wide (952 mm to 978 mm).
- 2- The mattress must be 75 inches long (1905 mm).
- 3- The mattress thickness must never exceed 9 inches (228.5 mm).
- 4- Never elevate the mattress. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 inches below the upper edge of the guardrails.
- 5- The sides must not exceed 1 inch (25 mm) when the mattress is centered.
The reason for this is to prevent injury if a person becomes stuck or falls off the bed.

Safety warnings

- 1- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
- 2- Carefully read and follow the assembly instructions.
- 3- Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- 4- To prevent the risks of entrapment between the bed and the wall, push the bunk bed flush against the wall after having first removed the wall baseboards.
- 5- If the bunk bed is placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
- 6- Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
- 7- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- 8- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- 9- Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
- 10- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- 11- Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- 12- Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
- 13- The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
- 14- Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed(s) and prohibit jumping on the bed(s).

Dimensiones del colchón (cama superior)

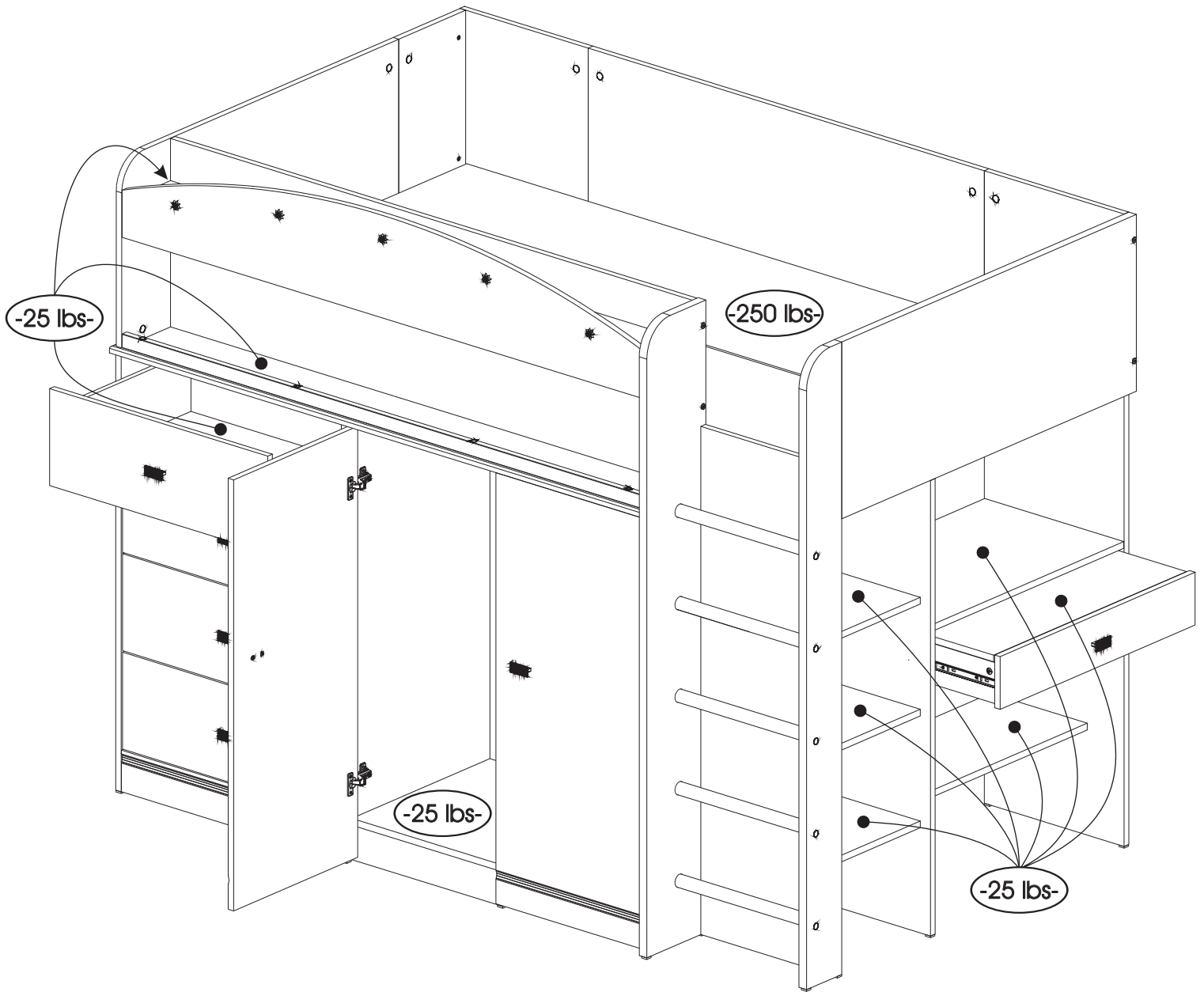
El único colchón aceptable para la Unidad Combinada debe corresponder a las medidas siguientes:

- 1- El ancho del colchón debe ser de 37,5 pulgadas a 38 pulgadas (952 a 978 milímetros).
- 2- El largo del colchón debe ser de 75 pulgadas (1905 milímetros).
- 3- El colchón no debe sobrepasar las 9 pulgadas de alto (228.5 milímetros) (espesor).
- 4- El colchón no debe ser elevado en caso alguno. Conservar una altura de al menos pulgadas del borde.
- 5- No debe nunca ser uno espacio de más que 1 pulgadas (25 milímetros) entre el colchón y los lados cuando el colchón es al centro. Evitando así las lastimaduras por causa de atascamiento o de caída.

Seguridad

- 1- Leer y seguir debidamente las instrucciones de ensamblado (que se encuentran sobre la caja y sobre la etiqueta de seguridad de la cama superior).
- 2- Utilizar un colchón de medidas apropiadas tal como se recomienda, es decir que una vez ubicado, quede entre el borde del colchón y la estructura de la cama un máximo de 1 pulgada (25 milímetros) en todo el perímetro, evitando así las lastimaduras por causa de atascamiento o de caída.
- 3- Para prevenir los riesgos atascamiento entre la cama y la pared, adosar la cama superpuesta contra la pared una vez que los zócalos hayan sido retirados.

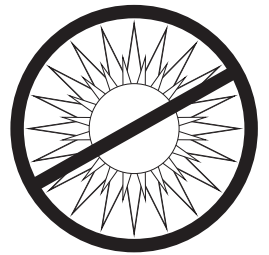

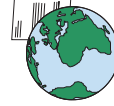
