

# Flexy Use and Care

Congratulations! You have just purchased one of the best-built sofa beds in the planet.

## How to open

- Once product is fully assembled, stand in front, facing the sofa, with two hands pull up until you can reach the storage area, the sofa (seating part) will stay at around 90 degrees.
- To close just push the unit down to its original position from the top of the seating part. Do not keep your hand below, as the unit will fall down with its own weight.

## How to convert into sleeping position

- Once sofa is on seating position, stand in front, facing the sofa, with two hands pull up until you can reach the storage position, you will see a leg in the front (bottom) part of the seating area, pull/slide to the front, as this will give additional support once the unit is folded all the way down. Then push more away from you, until you hear two "clicks" from the mechanism, as the system is unlocking. At this point, you will feel the unit to be loose. Bring down the unit all the way to the bottom, as this will sit on the frame to support the unit.
- Follow the same steps for the other side of the split unit, for the bed to convert into its full sleeping position.

#### How to close back into seating position

Once sofa is on sleeping position, stand in front, facing the sofa, with two hands pull up and push towards the back of the unit, until you hear "one click", this means the mechanism is locking into place, if you hear "two clicks", you went too far and the mechanism will not lock.

If the mechanism is properly locked (you heard "one click") and is staying in place on its own, push back the support leg all the way in, and then pull down from the top of the seating, until it goes all the way down into full seating position. Make sure to push it only from the top and there is not other object at the bottom in between the storage and the seat.

#### Fabric Care

Performance fabric is easy to clean. Wipe with a wet cloth. Do not use chemicals, as this may damage the surface of the material.
