The concentration of the indicated contaminate in water entering the system was reduced to a concentration less than or equal to the permissible limit for water leaving the system, as specified in NSF/ANSI 42 and 53. While testing was performed under standard laboratory conditions, actual performance may vary. The Home Master® MINI Filter met standard testing requirements for cyst reduction and may be used on disinfected waters that may contain filterable cysts.
