







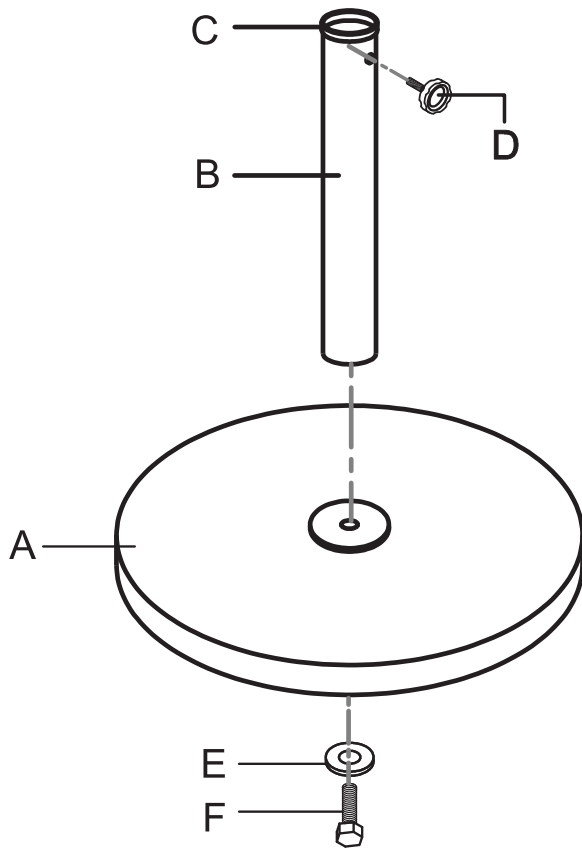
## CAST IRON UMBRELLA BASE

Read and follow all instructions before assembling and using this product. Keep these instructions in a safe place for future reference.

**Assemble the umbrella base on a smooth, clean surface to avoid scratching or damaging the finish.**

### PARTS:

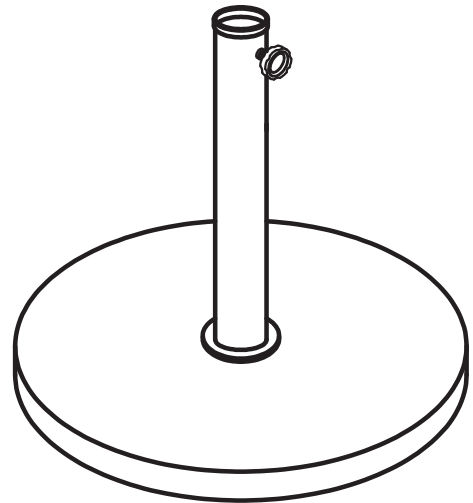
A	 Base (style may vary)	1
B	 Pole	1
C	 Adapter	1
D	 Adjustable Handle	1
E	 Flat Washer	1
F	 Bolt	1



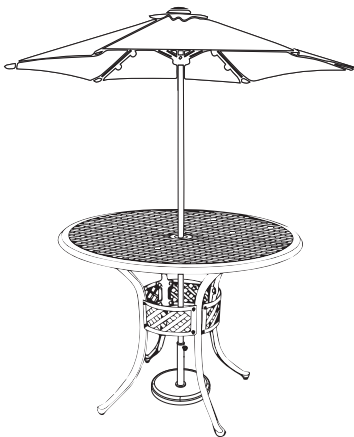
### ASSEMBLY

- ▶ Place flat washer (E) onto bolt (F) and insert through the bottom of base (A).
- ▶ Attach pole (B) onto the base (A).
- ▶ Screw the adjustable handle (D) into umbrella pole (B).
- ▶ Adjust adapter (C) to fit your umbrella pole.

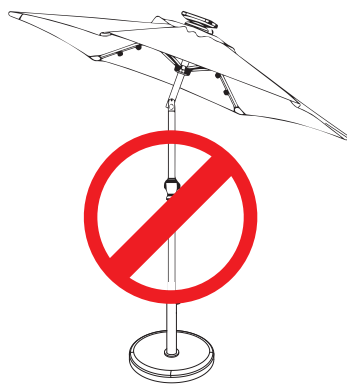
If the pole feels unstable, secure it more firmly to the base by holding the pole and tightening the bolt with a wrench. Do not over-tighten the bolt as it may strip the bolt and damage the product, invalidate the product warranty.

Incorrect Use

- This is not a freestanding umbrella base; the base must be used under a table designed to support an umbrella pole.
- Check for and empty standing water from the base.
- Do not stand on the base – it is only meant to support the weight of an umbrella.
- Store in a dry location when not in use – do not leave exposed to inclement weather.
- Clean with mild soap and water – use of harsh chemicals may damage the product and will invalidate the product warranty.
- Do not over-tighten the adjustable handle as it may damage your umbrella pole.
- Close patio umbrellas when not in use and remove umbrellas during high-wind conditions; the base is designed only to support an umbrella and will not protect your umbrella from wind damage.

**Any modification or failure to follow the recommended care will void the product warranty.**
