

TROUBLESHOOTING:

	Possible Cause	Corrective Action
Bulb will not light.	1. Bulb is burned out.	1. Replace light bulb.
	2. Power is off.	2. Make sure power supply is on.
	3. Faulty wire connection.	3. Check wiring.
Fuse blows or circuit breaker trips when light is turned on.	Crossed wires or power wire is grounding out.	Check wire connections.

PRODUCT MAINTENANCE:

1. To clean the outside of the fixture, use a dry or slightly dampened clean cloth (use clean water, never a solvent) to wipe the shade and surface of the fixture.
2. To clean the inside of the fixture, first disconnect power to the fixture by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Next, use a dry or slightly dampened clean cloth (use clean water, never a solvent) to wipe the inside shade and interior surface of the fixture.
3. Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents or harsh abrasives. Use only a dry soft cloth to dust or wipe carefully.

LIMITED WARRANTY



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:


1. Carefully unpack the fixture; lay out all parts on clean surface.
2. Tightening center threaded nipple (16) to the nipple extension (12) (part of the fixture main body).
3. Place metal suppose (17) onto center threaded nipple (16).
4. Insert glass shade (18) over center nipple (16), secure by placing one scilicon washer (19) and metal washer (20) over center threaded nipple (16). Tighten by using lower lock nut (21).
5. Mount decorative metal base (22) onto glass assembly then tighten bottom finial (23) onto center threaded nipple (16).
6. Install 60W max. A19 bulbs (not included).

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Turn off power at main fuse box.
2. Mount mounting plate to junction box (1) with outlet box screws (10). Make sure black and white wires of junction box (1) run through the middle opening of the mounting plate.
3. Fasten open end of ground wire (bare copper or green wire), to ground wire or ground screw (9) of junction box (1) or ground screw (9) on cross bar (3). (Refer to Figure #1).
4. Connect black wire of power supply to black wire of the fixture and connect the white wire of the power supply to the white wire of the fixture. (Refer to Figure #1).

NOTE: Always use wire connectors (2) or marettes (included) to connect wires and push all excess wire and connections back into junction box (1).

5. Mount canopy (6) over cross bar (3) and tighten with 2 finishing nuts (11).


