For best performance, periodically sharpen the V-edge of your knives using a wetstone or our NEW Cuisinart™ Knife Sharpener for special V-edge knives. In between sharpenings, use the steel rod included with your set to keep knife edges honed and clean. Hand-wash cutlery for best results. To clean block surface, wipe with a warm, wet cloth/sponge and towel-dry immediately. **Do not immerse in water.**

If your cutlery should crack or chip within your lifetime, we will replace it without charge to you, except for shipping and handling.
