
Chair Assembly

1 Connecting the chair back to the right arm

- Place the right arm (B) on a soft surface.
- Insert the joint of the chair back (A) into the hole of the right arm (B) as shown below.
- Secure the chair back (A) to the right arm (B) with an M6x30 combination bolt (BB).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).




Chair Assembly (continued)

2 Connecting the chair back to the left arm

- Place the left arm (C) on a soft surface.
- Insert the joint of the chair back (A) into the hole of the left arm (C) as shown below.
- Secure the chair back (A) to the left arm (C) with an M6x30 combination bolt (BB).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).




Chair Assembly (continued)

3 Connecting the chair seat to the right arm

- Attach the chair seat (D) to the right arm (B) using M6x35 combination bolts (AA) and an M6x30 combination bolt (BB).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).




Chair Assembly (continued)

4 Connecting the chair seat to the left arm

- Attach the chair seat (D) to the left arm (C) using M6x35 combination bolts (AA) and an M6x30 combination bolt (BB).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).




Chair Assembly (continued)

5 Connecting the chair leg to the chair seat

- Attach the chair leg (E) to the chair seat (D) using M6x30 combination bolts (BB).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).



Chair Assembly (continued)

6 Tightening the bolts

- Once all bolts are in place, fully tighten all the bolts.
- Turn the chair right side up.
- Ensure that all connections are secure before use.
- Place the pillow (F) to finish the assembly of the chair.




Table Assembly

1 Attaching the table legs to the table top

- Place the table top (G) upside down on a soft surface.
- Attach the table legs (H) to the table top (G) using M6x20 combination bolts (CC).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).




Table Assembly (continued)

2 Attaching the leg connector to the table legs

- Attach the leg connector (I) to the table legs (H) using M6x20 combination bolts (CC).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (DD).





Table Assembly (continued)

3 Tightening the bolts

- Once all bolts are in place, fully tighten all the bolts.
- Turn the table right side up.
- Ensure that all connections are secure before use.



Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the frame and fabric with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the set in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the set away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
