

# CLEAR<sub>2</sub>O Quick Start Card



## Step 1 Identify Your Faucet

Identify and remove your faucet's aerator. If your faucet has an aerator, unscrew it as shown below in figure A1 and A2 (Your aerator may look different)

INSIDE THREAD




Important: The aerator has a rubber washer that gets stuck to the metal faucet. Be sure to remove the rubber washer from the faucet.

## Step 2

Your aerator installation kit includes:

- Clear<sub>2</sub>O aerator
- Two different sized adapters each with a rubber washer.



## Step 3 Procedure

Install CLEAR<sub>2</sub>O aerator to your faucet.

Note: You will only need to use the CLEAR<sub>2</sub>O aerator for this procedure.

Faucet with Outside Rim



Install aerator with adapter with thread inside



Make sure the adapter has the rubber washer in place. If not, insert the rubber washer into the adapter.

Once you have the adapter that fits your faucet, screw it onto the faucet.

Tighten the adapter in place.

Once the adapter is secure, screw the wide end of the CLEAR<sub>2</sub>O aerator onto the adapter with the permanent rubber washer in place.

Never remove the rubber washers from the CLEAR<sub>2</sub>O aerator.

## Step 4 Ready to Attach Connector to Faucet



Grip the connector with one hand and with the free hand, push down the outer ring.



Keeping the outer ring in the down position, place the connector under the faucet and push it up onto the faucet to fit securely in place.

Important: To avoid damage to the faucet connector, you must push down the outer ring before pushing the connector onto the faucet.

## Step 5 Ready for Filtered Water



Turn the faucet to cold water.

Important: You must use municipally treated / private well, portable water.

Never use hot water (above 85°F)



Open the faucet enough so that water flows through the hose.

Important: To avoid overflow, do not use too much water pressure.

Fill the pitcher to the MAX line. Do not overfill.

Discard the first 3 pitchers of filtered water to flush the system.



## Step 6



Once the pitcher is filled with the desired amount of water, again push down the outer ring and then pull down the connector to disconnect from the faucet.

Wipe the connector dry.



When finished, insert the quick-connect house and connector into the storage compartment.

Keep the new faucet adapter attached in place.

## Step 7

### Replacing the filter

Replace Filter

Your CLEAR<sub>2</sub>O pitcher has an intelligent Filter indicator built into the filter cover that automatically activates to the flow meter indicator and resets it every time you install a new filter.

Making it easy to know exactly when to replace the filter.



To remove the filter, lift the filter, lift the lid and open the lid.

Turn the bar on the filter counter clockwise to the unlocked position. Keep turning the bar until the filter is released.

Pull out the filter and discard.
