Button	Description
Pre Wash "Child Lock	 (Press before wash cycle) Pre-wash heavily soiled laundry (See page 26). (Press and hold during wash cycle) Activates or cancels Child Lock feature. (See page 27).
● TurboWash*	Use this option to save time (See page 27).
Extra Rinse *Grun Light	(Press before wash cycle) Add an extra rinse to the selected cycle. (see page 26.) (Press and hold during wash cycle) The drum is equipped with a white LED light that illuminates when the washer is turned on. (see page 28.)
Rinse+Spin	Use this option to rinse detergent from the load (See page 26)
Delay Wash	Set the start time of the wash cycle. (See page 26).
© Steam *Fresh Care	(Press before starting wash cycle) Use this option to add steam for extra cleaning power (See page 26) (Press and hold before starting wash cycle) Tumbles clothes after cycle finishes to prevent wrinkles (See page 28)
© Cold Wash™	Use this option to help reduce energy consumption (See page. 27).
Custom PGM *PGM Save	(Press and hold) Saves the current cycle and settings for use at a later time. (Press once) Restores the previously saved settings. (See page 27~28)

Display



Display Icon	Description		
	This portion of the display shows which stage of the wash cycle is currently underway (Load Sensing, Wash, Rinse or Spin).		
⊗	 Indicates that the door is locked. The washer door will lock while the washer is operating. The door can be unlocked by pressing the Start/ Pause button to stop the washer. 		
Ü	This indicator shows that the washer has been set for Delay Wash. The washer will start automatically after the set delay time has passed.		
1:30	When the Start/ Pause button is pressed, the washer automatically detects the wash load (weight) and optimizes the washing time, based on the selected cycle and options. The display will then indicate the estimated time remaining for the selected wash cycle.
