OPERATING SOLAR LIGHT

Instructions For First Time Use


Allow lantern to charge for at least 8 hours in full sunlight with the OFF/ON switch in the OFF position. The OFF/On switch is located under the solar panel (See Figure 4). The switch has three positions BW, OFF, and WW. Once the batteries are fully charged, set the switch to the BW for blue white light or WW for white light. If the lantern doesn't turn on after initial charging, ensure batteries are making contact with terminals.



Battery Replacement

NOTE: The batteries in your solar lantern come pre-installed from the factory.

- 1. **(SEE FIGURE 5)** Twist the top of lantern head counter clock wise to remove solar panel housing.
- Carefully lift the solar panel housing off the lantern head. Batteries compartment is located under the solar panel.
- 3. Remove old batteries.
- Replace old batteries with new ones of the same rating. Reference polarity direction inside battery compartment.
- Align tabs on lantern head with the holes on solar panel housing. Twist solar panel housing clock wise to secure.
- The rechargeable batteries need to be fully charged before operating light assembly. See "Operating Solar Light" to restore solar light assembly to full operation.

Where To Place the Solar Light


Place the solar light in an area where it will receive direct sunlight for at least 8 hours per day. The number of hours light is illuminated is directly proportional to the number of hours of sunlight it receives. If the light is placed in a shaded area, it will not be able to fully charge and its burn time will be limited. Do not place the light near other outdoor lighting like porch or streetlights. These may fool the sensor and keep the light from coming on, or cause it to turn off automatically.

Assembly With Planter


1. (See Figure 1) Attach the extension post (F) to the planter base (H). Next attach decorative post (C) to extension post (F). Attach the top finial (D) to decorative post (C). Attach the lantern adapter (B) on top of the scrolled arm of the decorative post and secure into place by tightening the bottom finial (E). Attach the lantern head (A) on top of the lantern adapter.



Stake Light Assembly

1. (See Figure 2) Attach the extension post (F) to the ground stake (G). Next attach decorative post (C) to extension post (F). Attach the top finial (D) to decorative post (C). Attach the lantern adapter (B) on top of the scrolled arm of the decorative post and secure into place by tightening the bottom finial (E). Attach the lantern head (A) on top of the lantern adapter.

⚠ CAUTION: To prevent product damage or personal injury from tip-over, lamp post planter base must be placed on a flat, level surface and be filled with minimum of 5-10 lbs. of gravel or stone.

Wall Mount Instructions

 (SEE FIGURE 3) Attach planter base (H) to wall using wall mounting hardware (I). Drill hole into wall or surface, next push the wall anchor into hole. Screw two screws into the wall anchors leaving the screws out enough to attach planter base (H). Remove the top finial (D) and screw the last screw through decorative post (C) into wall anchor. Reattach top finial (D) to decorative post (C).
